<b>True Multimonitor support</b> Applications behave in RDP sessions spanning over multiple monitors the same as locally (maximize over just 1 monitor etc.)**	✓	✓	✓
<b>Aero Glass Remoting</b> Support of 3D effects and transparency over RDP (not on Windows 7 Starter and Home Basic - only works on certain operating systems. Aero Glass Remoting FAQ entry <a href="http://www.thinstuff.com/faq/index.php?solution_id=1060">http://www.thinstuff.com/faq/index.php?solution_id=1060</a> )	✓	✓	✓
<b>Enhanced Application Compatibility</b> Compatibility mode for legacy applications which are not Terminal Server capable	✗	✓	✓
<b>Domain authentication of Remote Desktop users</b> (The XP/VS Server system must be member of a Windows Server Domain - does not work on Windows Home Editions)	✗	✓	✓

<p><b>TSX RemoteApp (Seamless Windows)</b>            Allows publishing of single applications seamlessly instead of publishing a complete desktop session. Applications published with <b>TSX RemoteApp</b> appear on the client desktop as if they were local            Works on all operating systems including Windows XP, Vista and Server 2003 (not supported in Windows 8/8.1/10 and Server 2012 (R2)/2016)            (requires <b>TSX Remote Desktop Connection</b> client on the client system)</p>	✘	✔	✔
<p><b>TSX Session Broker (Load Balancing)</b>            Based on server load values incoming RDP sessions are automatically assigned to individual servers in multiple server environments            (The XP/VS Server system must be member of a Windows Server Domain - does not work on Windows Home editions, Windows 8/8.1./10/ Windows Server 2012 (R2)/2016)</p>	✘	✔	✔
<p><b>TSX USB</b>            Allows you to use all client attached USB devices in your Remote Desktop session as if they were directly attached to the local USB port of the server. This is useful for e.g. USB flatbed scanners, MFC devices (printer, scanner, fax), handhelds, mobile phones, webcams etc. (Please note USB 3.0 is not supported)</p>	✘	✘	✔
<p><b>RemoteFX</b>            Basically RemoteFX for Thinstuff XP/VS Terminal Services gives you the same features as Microsoft RemoteFX on Windows 2008R2 Remote Desktop Session Host (RemoteFX/RDSH). Please also note that RemoteFX for Thinstuff Terminal Services requires a XP/VS Professional license to work.</p>	✘	✘	✔
